



VEEP high points:

- An electrical training ALLIANCE sponsored, directed, and approved Pre-Apprenticeship program – Meeting Direct Entry Allowance in Standards for Accepting JATCs.
- JATCs are allowed under 2011 or newer standards to allow direct entry for a defined scope of time, defined number of participants, and for a defined program, therefore accepting one applicant does not “open a floodgate”.
- VEEP Supports Active duty or recently separated Military Veterans from all branches.
- A Pre-Apprenticeship Program provided at no cost to participant.
- Provides Direct Entry path for program graduate into Registered Apprenticeship. Direct entry is the outcome, not direct interview.
- Candidates designate top three “home base locations” and the etA works to get them accepted in the top available choice of receiving location.
- The Inside 1st Year Curriculum, plus Building a Foundation in Mathematics Level I, plus level 1 Craft Certification performance evaluation is the basis of the pre-apprenticeship. A pre-hire drug screening is administered.
- First Aid/CPR, OSHA-10 are also included.
- Accepting JATC’s must have 2011 or Newer (Current) Standards and agree to accept the graduate via direct entry.
- etA is the sponsor of the pre-apprenticeship program, delivery of content is by the training JATC.
- Expectations are that a participant will follow local policies administered locally at the training JATC while in pre-apprenticeship.
- Participants are not registered apprentices until they are at the accepting JATC
